A meeting of the Grants Committee for the above scheme was held on 29 June 2010 in National Archives of India, New Delhi under the Chairpersonship of Dr (Ms) T. Kumar, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Culture, Government of India:

The meeting was also attended by Ms. Tejinder Ahluwalia, Assistant Director of Archives

Welcoming the Members, the Chairperson apprised them of the aims and objectives of the scheme and also the maximum limit of the Financial Assistance admissible under the scheme. She also informed that a comprehensive review of the scheme is already underway and the present meeting has been convened primarily to clear cases already received in the National Archives of India. Subsequently, the Agenda items were taken up for consideration and the following decisions taken:

Part A

Fourteen proposals that were complete in all respects were taken for consideration and the following decisions were taken:

- Grants Committee recommended a total grant of Rs.5,57,275/- (Rupees Five Lakhs Fifty Seven Thousand Two Hundred Seventy Five only) to 7 NGOs/ Individuals, which includes grantees matching share of Rs.1,39,318/- (Rupees One Lakh Thirty Nine Thousand Three Hundred Eighteen only) @ 25% and Central share of Rs.4,17,957/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Seventeen Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Seven only) @ 75% of the grant amount. (For details please see Annexure-I).
- 2. In 5 cases where more details of holding etc. were required, the Grants Committee authorized the Director General, National Archives of India, Janpath, New Delhi-110 001 to take appropriate decision on their financial proposals after satisfying himself on receipt of the additional information from the applicants. (For details please see Annexure-II).
- 3. The Grants Committee did not recommend Financial Assistance to 4 NGOs/ Individuals of Part A of the Agenda as the financial proposals submitted by them were not found suitable according to the Scheme (For details please see Annexure-III).

Part B

The Committee did not recommend financial assistance to 15 Organizations/ Individuals (incomplete proposals) out of 16 proposals of part B of the Agenda due to pending utilization certificates, non-receipt of State Archives/ SLSC recommendation and in the absence of any specific information about their holdings viz. Manuscripts/ rare books etc. (For details please see Annexure-III). One proposal was deferred and has been included at Sr. No.2 of the deferred cases listed in Annexure-II.

Part C

- The Grants Committee re-considered the case of Shri Keshab Ch. Bhuyan, an Individual grantee of Assam, who had refused to accept the grant of Rs.7,500/- sanctioned to him during 2009-10. The Grants Committee unanimously decided not to alter the recommendation of the earlier Grants Committee.
- 2. The Grants Committee also discussed the case of audit objection of Shri Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwara College, Ujire, Karnataka wherein amount of Rs. 9,000/- was recommended for 5 tables and Rs.7,500/- was recommended for 25 Chairs (Total Rs.16,500/-) as Central share. The Grants Committee opined that more care should be taken in future while considering such cases which are beyond the scope of the Scheme.

The Chairperson observed that the proposals received through State Archives/ SLSC generally lack categorical recommendations regarding the specific items admissible under the Scheme or the extent of the financial recommended in each case. Even where an amount has been recommended by them, no justification is given for such a recommendation. All this makes decision-making for the Grants Committee difficult.

The Members of the Grants Committee shared the concern of the Chairperson and unanimously suggested that a specific format for providing recommendations may be prescribed for the State Archives/ SLSC regarding financial assistance to NGOs/ Individuals.

It was also agreed that the National Archives of India would "search" worthy proposals for funding under the Scheme. Director General of Archives would pilot them, along the lines discussed. Experts may be associated to assess the intrinsic merit of the proposals.

The experience of implementing the Scheme, by National Archives of India should be duly reflected in the revised Scheme so that its primary objective is achieved.

The meeting concluded with a Vote of Thanks to the Chair.

Welcoming the Members, the Chairperson apprised them of the aims and objectives of the scheme and also the maximum limit of the Financial Assistance admissible under the scheme. She also informed that a comprehensive review of the scheme is already underway and the present meeting has been convened primarily to clear cases already received in the National Archives of India.

The members of the Grants Committee observed that almost fifty percent of the applications included in the Agenda (Part A) were from individuals, all having very limited number of manuscripts/ rare books in their collections. In most of the cases it was not evident if these materials were available for consultation by the public. The Grants Committee, therefore, recommended that all these individual applicants seeking financial assistance for publication/ translation of manuscripts or for reprint of rare books may be advised to approach the Indian Council Historical for Research (ICHR), New Delhi. Similarly, the individual applicants having limited number of manuscripts and rare books in their collection and seeking their conservation may be advised to approach the National Manuscripts Mission, New Delhi or one of its Manuscript Conservation Centres (MCCs) where expertise/facilities for Preservation of Manuscripts and Rare Books are available.

Subsequently, the Agenda items were taken up for consideration and the following decisions taken:

Part A

- 1. Grants Committee recommended a total grant of ₹8,32,000/- (₹Eight Lakhs Thirty Two Thousand only) to 8 NGOs which includes grantees matching share of ₹2,08,000/- (₹ Two Lakhs Eight Thousand only) @ 25% and Central share of ₹6,24,000/- (₹ Six Lakhs Twenty Four Thousand only) @ 75% of the grant amount (For details please see Annexure-I).
- The Grants Committee did not recommend Financial Assistance to 8 Individuals of Part A of the Agenda as the financial proposals submitted by them were not found suitable according to the scope of the scheme (For details please see Annexure-II).

Part B

The Committee did not recommend financial assistance to 1 NGO and 1 Individual (incomplete proposals) of Part B of the Agenda due to pending utilization certificates, non-receipt of State Archives/ SLSC recommendation and in the absence of any specific information about the financial proposals (For details please see Annexure-II).



A meeting of the Grants Committee for the above scheme was held on 17 March 2011 in National Archives of India, New Delhi under the Chairpersonship of Dr (Ms) T. Kumar, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Culture, Government of India.

- 2. Welcoming the Members, the Chairperson apprised them of the aims and objectives of the Scheme. She also informed that a comprehensive review of the Scheme has already taken place, which envisages, inter alia, a substantial increase in the grant amount. The Chairperson emphasized the need for a proper monitoring mechanism for proper utilization of the grants amount released. The present meeting has been convened in response to the advertisement published on 26 December, 2010.
- 3. The members of the Grants Committee were briefed about the Agenda (Part A) which consisted of 29 complete cases, out of which 16 cases were from States other than North East i.e. Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh, and West Bengal & 13 cases from North East States (Assam).

Subsequently, the Agenda items were taken up for consideration and the following decisions taken by the Grants Committee:

Part A -I-States other than North-East

a. The Grants Committee considered 16 proposals which were complete in all aspects, out of which 13 cases from the State of Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal were recommended.
