The Second Grants Committee meeting was conducted as some allocated fund amount of the Scheme remained unspent. The proposals of financial assistance were invited upto 6 February 2018. In response, 5 proposals were received.

The Member Secretary informed the main features of the Scheme as well as the remaining fund available for disbursement during the current financial year (2017-2018).

Total 5 proposals received from State Archival Repositories and Government Libraries were taken up for consideration.

Part-I

1. Only 1 proposal of Madhya Pradesh State Archives was complete in all respects and the same was approved by Grants Committee for an amount of Rs. 37,22,143/- (Central Share).

The total approved Grant amount is Rs. 49,62,858/- (Rupees Forty Nine Lakhs Sixty Two Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty Eight only) to 1 State Government Institution i.e Madhya Pradesh State Archives, Bhopal which includes grantee State Government 25% matching share of Rs.12,40,715/- (Rupees Twelve Lakhs Forty Thousand Seven Hundred Fifteen only) and Central Government 75% share of Rs. 37,22,143/- (Rupees Thirty Seven Lakhs Twenty Two Thousand One Hundred Forty Three only).

Part-II

The Grants Committee also extended approval in principle to the proposals of 2 other State Government Institutions i.e. Himachal Pradesh State Archives, Shimla and Museum Reference Library, Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala, subject to the fulfillment of conditions as receipt of State Govt. Assurance of 25% matching share within current financial year i.e. 2017-18. The grant amount will be released on first come first serve basis subject to the availability of funds.

The Committee did not approve 2 cases which are at Annexure III along with reasons.

As the Grant amount of Rs. 37,50,000/- recommended to Punjab State archives, Chandigarh in the first Grants Committee meeting, held on 7 September 2017, is yet to be released as their bank details are still awaited, the Grants Committee recommended that they may be asked to send the bank details upto 10 March 2018, failing which grants may be released to institutions who have been conditionally recommended grant subject to receipt of requisite papers on first come first serve basis.

The Budget

For the year 2017-2018, a sum of Rs. 1,00,00,000/- has been allocated under BE (Plan) for States under Major Head 2205 under this Scheme.

The Committee suggested to conduct a meeting in April 2018 with all Heads of State/UT Archives to have interactive session with them and also desired to ask Commissioner, Tamil Nadu State Archives, Chennai to give presentation on their record holdings and the work done from the grant amount released by NAI.
