the United Provinces Government of a portion  
of the compound.

Sir,

With reference to the correspondence ending with  
your letter No. 3555-C, dated the 23rd November,  
1110-1939  
1939, I am directed to convey the sanction of the  
Government of India to the transfer to the Provincial  
Government of a portion of the compound of the Chattar  
Manzil Palace, Lucknow, measuring nearly 0.06 acre,  
as shown in the plan enclosed with your letter dated  
the 26th June, 1939. The transfer will be subject to  
the payment of the market value of the land, in  
accordance with paragraph 3(c) of this Department  
letter No. F.172-1/35-L.&O., dated the 15th June, 1939,  
and to removal of the existing wire fencing and its  
re-erection on the new boundary by the Provincial  
Government.

2. There is a sharp bend in mile 1 of the Lucknow-  
Pareilly road near the west gate of the Chatter Mahal  
palace between the quarters of the Members of the House  
of Revenue and the Board of Revenue office. At this point  
the road is narrow and the curve sharp. This corner is  
a source of danger to the travelling public, and the  
Provincial Government proposed to widen the road at this  
40 ft. in a length of 335 ft. as shown in the accompany-  
ing plan. For this purpose, it is necessary to encroach  
on a portion (.66 acre) of the compound of the Chatter  
Mahal. The United Service Club, which occupies the  
Chatter Mahal, has no objection to the relinquishment  
BS.

3. As the ownership of the Chatter Mahal vests in  
the Central Government, I am to request the transfer  
of this portion of the Chatter Mahal compound to the  
Provincial Government, and the removal of the  
building from its present position, marked white in the  
plan, to that shown in red in the plan.

Subject:- Transfer of a portion of the compound of the  
Chattar Manzil palace (used by the United  
Service Club), Lucknow, to the Provincial  
Government for widening the Lucknow-Bareilly  
road near the West gate of the Chattar Manzil.

I am directed to invite a reference to the Govern-  
ment of India, Department of Education, Health and Lands,  
notification no.2323 EDN, dated November 24, 1925, in  
which certain ancient monuments in the United Provinces,  
including the Chattar Manzil palace at Lucknow, were  
removed from the list of Central-charge monuments sub-  
ject to the observance by this Government of the conditions  
specified therein.

2. There is a sharp bend in mile 1 of the Lucknow-  
Bareilly road near the west gate of the Chattar Manzil  
palace between the quarters of the Members of the Board  
of Revenue and the Board of Revenue office. At this point  
the road is narrow and the curve sharp. This corner is  
a source of danger to the travelling public, and the  
Provincial Government propose to widen the road at this <sup>point to</sup> 40 ft. in a length of 325 ft. as shown in the accompany-  
ing plan. For this purpose, it is necessary to encroach  
on a portion (.06 acre) of the compound of the Chattar  
Manzil, The United Service Club, which occupies the  
Chattar Manzil, has no objection to the relinquishment  
of this area for widening the road.

3. As the ownership of the Chattar Manzil vests in  
the Central Government, I am to request the transfer  
of this portion of the Chattar Manzil compound to the  
Provincial Government, and the removal of the wire  
fencing from its present position, marked white in the  
plan, to that shown in red in the plan.
